1. NAME

The Colin Rush Study Award (Generously sponsored by James Hardie FRC).

2. FORM

The award is in the form of up to \$1,500 for successful applicant to conduct career development studies. The winner will also receive a certificate of citation.

3. PURPOSE

The primary purpose of the Colin Rush Study Award is to promote the professional development of Queensland Works Officers within the following topics;

- Civil Construction and Maintenance
- Road Safety and Traffic Management
- Quality/Environmental/Safety Management Systems
- Benchmarking, etc

4. FREQUENCY

The Colin Rush Study Award is made available through the generous sponsorship of James Hardie FRC and is allocated to one person in each financial year of the Association. **Applications must be received by 4.00pm on 20th August of current year.**

5. PROCEDURE FOR APPLICATION

Applications can be made and will be accepted from financial members of the Works Officers Association of Queensland Incorporated.

Applications must be accompanied by a completed 'Colin Rush Study Award Application Form' (located on the reverse side of this document).

Supporting documentation may be attached to the application form.

6. AWARD COMMITTEE

The award committee shall consist of the State Executive Committee of the Works Officers Association of Queensland Incorporated.

7. PROCEDURE FOR MAKING THE AWARD

The making of the award will be via a majority vote of the State Executive Committee of the Works Officers Association of Queensland Incorporated.

Once awarded, no further correspondence will be entered into.

The award amount is the total amount available. No further claim may be made which is above the award amount.

8. ANNOUNCEMENT OF AWARD WINNER AND PRESENTATION OF AWARD

The announcement of the winner of the Colin Rush Study Award will be made during the Annual General Meeting of the Works Officers Association of Queensland Incorporated by a representative from James Hardie FRC or the President of the Works Officers Association of Queensland Incorporated.

9. AWARD CONDITIONS

The study award allows for the successful applicant to attend an approved conference or study tour worldwide. The successful applicant will be required to produce a report in writing to the President of the Works Officers Association of Queensland Incorporated.

The successful applicant shall make adequate arrangements for health and accident insurance prior to taking up their award.

Two copies of the award application must be received by the State Secretary of the Works Officers Association of Queensland Incorporated by the start of August, in order that it may be considered by the State Executive Committee.
